Hollywood stars discovered the resort in the 1940s and have been coming ever since – from Marilyn Monroe sunning at her favorite pool (Catalina Pool) to Frank Sinatra and Liza Minnelli giving impromptu concerts at the lobby piano to Bruce Springsteen vacationing with his family.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

- 740 guest accommodations in five categories of guest rooms including 86 suites.
- Guestrooms range from 400 to 600 square feet and feature: king bed or two queen beds, sitting area with desk, high-speed internet, cable TV, in-room movies, 2 phone lines, mini-bar, safe, iron/ironing board, bathrobes; many offer panoramic views of the mountains and resort gardens.
- Suites range from 700 to 1,600 square feet and feature 10-to-15-foot ceilings, private terraces and balconies, marble baths and gas fireplaces.
- Every U.S. president since Herbert Hoover (except President Obama) has stayed in the plush and spacious 1,300-sq.-ft. *Signature Suite* with a master bedroom, adjoining bedroom, large living room, walled-in terrace and panoramic views of the hotel gardens and Paradise Pool; the central location at the heart of the resort allows the entire wing to be blocked off for security purposes.
- The exclusive *Ocatilla at Arizona Biltmore*, a “hotel within the hotel,” features enhanced guest services, 120 luxurious club accommodations, a private lounge offering a wide array of complimentary amenities and extras, and a private pool area with food and beverage service.

DINING & ENTERTAINMENT:

- **Wright’s at The Biltmore:** The resort’s signature restaurant prepares classic favorites reinvented for today’s tastes. Original recipes of classic dishes – from Beef Wellington to Veal Loin Oscar – are refreshed with innovative touches and the latest culinary trends to create timeless cuisine.
- **Frank & Albert’s:** Serving comfort food with an Arizona twist and hand-crafted cocktails in a dramatic venue with familiar yet vibrant energy, an exhibition kitchen and beautiful garden views.
- **The Wright Bar:** Specialty cocktails are served in a sleek ambiance of black-granite, polished wood and an open design that sweeps guests from the lobby to a patio with fire pits, market umbrellas and spectacular mountain panoramas. A favorite daily evening indulgence is the “High Tini” menu, combining trend-setting martinis with an array of taste bud-popping appetizers.
- **The Cafe:** Casual bistro serving coffee drinks, breakfast favorites, and deli sandwiches and salads.
